Profil souhaité:

Applicants should have a master's degree (or equivalent) in geography or environmental sciences, with good knowledge in physical geography (hydrology, climatology) and skills in social sciences methods (interviews, surveys), in quantitative methods and GIS.

The applicants should have the goal of completing a Ph.D. thesis in one of the following fields:

- (1) Integrated water management, preferentially in mountain regions, in particular on water management monitoring issues;
- (2) landscape transformations – in particular in fluvial valleys – with geohistorical approaches.

Description des tâches:

The successful candidate will contribute to teaching in geography (Bachelor and Master levels), in particular on physical geography methods (Bachelor) and on territorial development of the Alpine areas, on water management and landscape studies (Master).

The successful candidate will devote at least 50% of her/his time to a PhD thesis and up to 50% to other projects and teaching.
