

Postdoctoral Researcher/Editorial Manager

University of Luxembourg

The Political Science Institute at the University of Luxembourg is seeking candidates for a two-year postdoctoral research position who will also assist with the operations of the peer-reviewed journal *Regions & Cohesion* (Berghahn Journals) which is based in the institute. The successful candidate will principally work on his/her own research project but the subject should broadly be related to the aims and scope of the journal (<http://journals.berghahnbooks.com/reco/>) which promotes the comparative examination of the human and environmental impacts of regional integration processes. The successful applicant will be expected to assist the editors with the daily operations of the journal including communications with authors and peer-reviewers. The University of Luxembourg is a multilingual and interdisciplinary institution so candidates with a Ph.D. in any of the social sciences can apply. *Regions & Cohesion* is published in English, Spanish and French so applicants should be fluent in at least two of these languages. Working knowledge of all three would be viewed favorably.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have received a PhD in a social science field before applying. They can apply up to eight years after completion of their Ph.D.

Application Process:

The postdoctoral position will be based in the political science institute at the University of Luxembourg and funded by the Fonds National de la Recherche (www.fnr.lu) according to their rules. Consequently, this is a two-step application process:

First, interested candidates are required to electronically submit the following materials to Harlan Koff, Associate Professor of Political Science, University of Luxembourg at Harlan.koff@uni.lu by January 20, 2012:

- 1-2 page cover letter that briefly states your academic background and interest in the position
- a summary of your proposed research project
- CV including the names and contact information of at least two references

Second, with Dr. Koff, the selected candidate will then submit an application for a postdoctoral grant to the Fonds National de la Recherche by February 20, 2012. Should the application be accepted by the FNR, the successful candidate would begin the position by September 2012.
